



# 2.4GHz 802.11b Wireless-B USB Network Adapter

Quick Installation for Windows XP



## 1 Connect the Wireless-B USB Network Adapter

- A** Power on your PC.
- B** The Adapter comes with the USB cable you will use to connect the Adapter to your PC.  
  
Connect one end of the included USB cable to the USB port of the Adapter.
- C** Connect the other end of the USB cable to one of the USB ports on your computer.  
  
The Power LED should light up when the Adapter is plugged in.
- D** Raise the antenna. Make sure the antenna is positioned straight up into the air, at a 90° angle from the Adapter. This will ensure optimum wireless operating range and performance.



## 2 Install the Driver

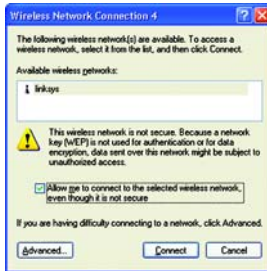
After connecting the Adapter to your computer, you will install the driver and configure the Adapter.

- A** Windows XP will automatically detect the Adapter. Insert the Setup CD-ROM into your computer's CD-ROM drive. Click the radio button next to *Install the software automatically (Recommended)*. Then click the **Next** button.
- B** When Windows has finished installing the driver, click the **Finish** button.



## 3 Configure the Wireless-B USB Network Adapter

- A** After the driver is installed, the Windows XP Wireless Zero Configuration icon will appear in your computer's system tray. Double-click the icon.  
  
If this network has WEP encryption enabled, go to step C.
- B** The screen that appears will show any available wireless network. Select the network you want.  
  
If this network does not have WEP encryption enabled, make sure the box next to *Allow me to connect to the selected wireless network, even though it is not secure* is checked. Click **Connect**, and go to step D.
- C** If WEP is enabled, enter the WEP key of your wireless network in the *Network key* field, and re-enter it in the *Confirm network key* field. Click **Connect**, and go to step D.
- D** The Zero Configuration icon will show a wireless connection when your connection is active.
